homes with young
children

Examine all
shades and blinds
for accessible cords
on the front, side
and back

Do not place cots,
beds and furniture close
to windows because children
can climb them and gain
access to window
covering cords

Check regularly
that cords are out of
reach of young children
and cannot form
hazardous loops
