

# Product Safety Recall

## Plum Silicone Soother



**Sold between 3 May 2021 and 24 June 2021**

### Defect

The product may have been damaged by its packaging, and the teat may break off the shield.

### Hazard

A broken teat may pose a choking hazard for young children, which can lead to severe injury or death.

### How is the product identified?

The packaging has a barcode marked "02/21"
