Defect The scooter's stem may develop a wobble, crack or fracture during use.

Hazard If the defect occurs while the scooter is being ridden, there is an increased risk of an accident or serious injury or death to the rider.

What to do Consumers should immediately stop using the scooter and take the scooter to their nearest Scooter Hut store (regardless of where purchased) to exchange the scooter for a different model of electric scooter, being the *InMotion S1 Electric Scooter*. If consumers have had the stem of their scooter replaced or repaired previously, these instructions still apply.
